

Aliwal Arts Centre

Aliwal Arts Centre is an arts centre housed in a 1938 Art Deco style conservation building that was home to two early Chinese schools. Living up to its illustrious past, the centre offers an inspired location within the historically and culturally rich Kampong Glam district for the artistic development of contemporary and traditional arts groups. As a placemaker in a neighbourhood hailed for its seamless blend of historic institutions, conserved shophouses and modern stores, Aliwal Arts Centre is also a platform for connecting the community with a mix of traditional and contemporary arts. To this end, it presents the popular Aliwal Arts Night Crawl, an annual presentation of arts with a focus on the area's rich heritage, and the Aliwal Urban Arts Festival, a celebration of art forms inspired by international street culture.







Multi-Purpose Hall

Located at the heart of Aliwal Arts Centre, this large, versatile hall is perfect for small-scale theatre and music performances, rehearsals as well as corporate events.




Multi-Purpose Studios A & B

Each studio is 64 square metres and available for individual bookings, or as a combined space with a total floor area of 128 square metres. With one studio fitted with mirrors, the space is popular for dance and theatre rehearsals, recitals, product launches and workshops.











Aliwal Arts Centre Floor Plan

Visiting Aliwal Arts Centre

By train

Circle Line - Alight at Nicoll Highway MRT (CC5), cross over Nicoll Highway and Beach Road via overhead bridge, cross over Jalan Sultan, turn right at Aliwal Street.

East West Line - Alight at Lavender MRT (EW11), Exit A, and board bus 107M at Kallang Road. Alight at Sultan Plaza, Jalan Sultan, 2 stops later. Cross over to Aliwal Street via shortcut between The Heritage Shop and The Sultan Hotel

Bv bus

From North Bridge Road - Bus numbers 7, 32, 51, 63, 80, 145, and 197.

From Victoria Street - Bus numbers 2, 7, 12, 32, 33, 51, 63, 80, 130, 133, 145, and 197.

From Beach Road - Bus numbers 10, 14, 16, 70, 100, 107, 196, and 401.

By car

Head towards North Bridge Road via Crawford Street/Jalan Sultan, turn left at Aliwal Street. Limited open air public carpark in front of Aliwal Arts Centre, or along Aliwal Street, Kandahar Street and Pahang Street. Recommended to park at nearby carparks along Jalan Sultan – Textile Centre, Sultan Plaza, and Keypoint. Parking charges apply.
